TAC044-16 Ocean Street Penshurst - Request to Extend the Existing No Stopping Restriction (14/1481)
(Report by Senior Traffic Engineer, Mrs S Selim)

Committee Recommendation

THAT the existing statutory No Stopping restriction in Ocean Street be extended further 5 metres south of Austral Street, Penshurst.

THAT a GIVE WAY restriction be installed for traffic on Austral Street at Ocean Street, Penshurst.

TAC045-16 Mavis Avenue Peakhurst - Request to Restrict Right Turn Movements onto Forest Road (15/806)

TAC047-16 2016 Lugarno Lions Festival - Gannons Park Peakhurst (14/375)

Committee Recommendation

THAT the following temporary traffic control measures be implemented on Sunday 18 September, 2016 to facilitate the 2016 Lugarno Lions Spring Festival at Gannons Park, Peakhurst:

1. Install a temporary "No Right Turn" restriction on Forest Road at Boatwright Avenue, Peakhurst to restrict westbound traffic on Boatwright Avenue from turning right into Forest Road, Peakhurst.
2. Install a temporary "No Right Turn" restriction on Isaac Street at Pindari Road, Peakhurst to restrict northbound traffic on Pindari Road from turning right into Isaac Street, Peakhurst.
3. Install a temporary "No stopping" restriction in Boatwright Avenue from Forest Road to the southern side of the main entrance of Gannons Park, Lugarno.
4. Install a temporary "No Parking" restriction on both sides of Boatwright Avenue, Bottlebrush Avenue and Ernest Street, Lugarno to clear on-street parking in these streets to improve traffic flow in the area.
5. Install a temporary "No Stopping" restriction in Isaac Street from Forest Road to Pindari Road, Peakhurst.
6. Install temporary "No Parking" signs on the eastern side of Jindabyne Cres., from the intersection of Pindari Road, Peakhurst Heights to the intersection of Whitegates Avenue, Peakhurst Heights.
7. THAT bus operators be notified of the proposed traffic management measures.
8. THAT a Traffic Management Plan (TMP) be submitted to the Police for the proposed traffic management measures.

FURTHER THAT Lugarno Lions Club be advised of Council's Decision.

TAC048-16 Wonoona Parade West Oatley - Request for a No Parking Restriction (16/670)

Committee Recommendation

THAT the request for a No Parking restriction across the driveway crossing of 3A Wonoona Parade West be denied.

TAC049-16 Hannans Road and Broadarrow Road Intersection - Road Safety Concerns (09/2057)

THAT a "Curve" Warning sign (W1-3A) and an advisory speed limit of 35km/h sign (W8-2) be installed just before the curve on Broadarrow Road outside 28 Broadarrow Road, Narwee.

THAT a crash barrier be installed along the southern kerb-line at the bend outside 30 Broadarrow Road, Narwee, subject to availability of funding.

FURTHER THAT Canterbury City Council and the resident be advised of council's decision.

TAC050-16 The Avenue Hurstville - Request for change No Parking to 10 minutes parking (15/273)

THAT the existing 6m No Parking restriction located along the side frontage of 75 Queens Road (House with No Steps) in The Avenue, Hurstville be changed to a P10minutes parking zone.

TAC051-16 Department of Defence Special Purpose Vehicles – Request for 3 years Permit to Use Council Road Network (16/360)

TAC052-16 Roberts Avenue, Mortdale - Request for a Pedestrian Crossing (13/226)

TAC053-16 Mona Road, Riverwood - Road Safety Concerns (14/1469)

THAT 10 metre statutory No Stopping restrictions be installed at the intersection of Mona Road and Broad Arrow Road, Riverwood.

TAC054-16 Kingsway, Kings Place, Westbrook Street and Glenwall Street Beverly Hills - Proposed New Roundabout (09/1889)
