The decision of the three (3) panel members was unanimous noting that Mr Cameron Jones did not participate in voting or discussions in this matter.

Refusal

The Georges River Council IHAP as the delegate of the Georges River Council determines that Development Application No. 2016/0053 for the mixed use development involving retention of existing lodge room, demolition of rear hall and construction of new four (4) storey building containing ground floor lodge facilities and ten (10) apartments above on the subject site at 11A Letitia Street, Oatley, be refused for the following reasons:

- The proposal provides insufficient justification for the height exceeding the 12 m height control in Kogarah Development Control Plan 2013 and the proposed maximum height development standard in Draft Amendment No. 2 Kogarah Local Environmental Plan 2012 (New City Plan).
- 2. The setback and separation of the proposed development from the rear boundary is inadequate and results in unacceptable impacts upon the amenity of the adjoining hotel site.
- 3. There is insufficient depth and width of landscaping to the rear of the site to reduce the amenity impacts on the adjoining hotel site.
- 4. Insufficient information has been provided to demonstrate that the car parking provided will be adequate to support the proposed development.
