

GEORGES RIVER COUNCIL COMMUNITY GRANTS PROGRAM 2018-2019 ROUND 1 SUMMARY OF APPLICATIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Georges River Council Community Grants Program 2018-2019 Round 1 closed on Monday 8 October 2018.

A total of 49 applications were received for funding, with funding requests totalling \$512,243.00.

The budget allocation for Round 1 of the 2018-2019 Community Grants Program is \$200,000.

This grant round comprised two categories:

Vibrant Georges River – Major Programs Grants of up to \$25,000 over 2 years for programs and projects that increase range of opportunities for local residents to participate in cultural activities and establish arts and cultural programs of significance;

Capacity Building Grants - Community Development Grants of up to \$10,000 to assist in the delivery of community programs and projects, especially those that benefit the most vulnerable communities and build capacity in the community.
