

AUSTRALIA DAY 2019 MANAGEMENT PLAN

Purpose:

The purpose of the Management Plan is to provide the operational overview of the Traffic and Transport management systems and processes required to be implemented for the **Australia Day Celebrations taking place on Saturday 26 January 2019 in Carss Bush Park off Carwar Avenue, Carss Park**. The event will be occurring between the hours of 10am and 9pm.

Operational Overview:

The operational traffic and transport management systems that are required to be implemented include the following key areas:

- a) Road Closures
- b) WATER BARRICADES
- c) Car Parking
- d) Signage
- e) Marshalls
- f) Key Contacts

Traffic and Transport Management Plans

The Traffic and Transport Management Plan has been drafted to facilitate the movement of vehicles and people into and around the event site being the Australia Day. The following aspects have been considered:

- People travelling to the venue by private vehicle
- VIP Guests arriving at the venue
- Residents
- Nearby Businesses
- Signage
- Police

Overview of Traffic and Transport

- Traffic Control Plans 1 – 3 will be implemented in order to facilitate the movement of traffic and Australia Day attendees.
- The southern end of Carwar Avenue, at the intersection to Carlton Crescent, will be shut with WATER barricades and marshalled with State Emergency Service Volunteers from 7am, with Emergency Services access only. The road will re-open at 10pm.
- Signs and marshals from either the SES or Georges River Council Depot will be situated at the intersection of Carwar Avenue and Carlton Crescent to direct people to the car parking area and to let Council or Emergency Service Vehicles past the Road Closed area.
- Signs and marshals from either the SES or Georges River Council Depot will be situated at the gate into the car parking area off Carlton Crescent.
- Carss Park Flats soccer field will be used as a temporary carpark for the carnival attendees.
- 50 carpark spaces are allocated to Australia Day Stallholders within the BUNYALA ST Car park
- 50 carpark spaces have been allocated to GRC employees and special guests in front of Dick Caine Swimming pool.
- No public transport (shuttle buses) will be organised for this event to control the amount of unsupervised children attending.

Traffic Control Plans

Traffic Control Plans are drafted to show the various locations around Australia Day Celebrations to assist people in accessing the event, from private vehicles.

The following TCP's have been identified:

TCP 1 – The entrance to Carss Bush Park off Carwar Ave & corner of Carwar Ave and Allawah Ave (North).

TCP 2 – Corner of Carwar Ave and Allawah Ave (South).

TCP 3 – The intersection of Carlton Crescent and Parkside Drive (parking site if Carss Park Flats overloads)

BUNYALA ST CAR PARK – NO MAP

Details about these TCP's are attached at the end of the report.

Event Signage

Temporary signage will be installed on the day of the event to assist drivers and pedestrians into and around the site. The event signage will be displayed in English only.

Event signage will consist of: Public car parking with directional arrows

- VIP Parking
- Gold Coin donation for parking
- Pedestrian access

Staffing Resources

Personnel and equipment resources are identified on each of the TCP's. The NSW Police have advised that they will be situating Officers and vehicles at the traffic signals at the intersections of Carwar Avenue and Princes Highway and the intersection of Borgah Street and Princes Highway if required at the end of the event. NSW Police Temporary Head Quarters will be made in the Carss Park Lifesaving Club on Carwar Ave. This space will also be base for the St John's Ambulance volunteers and State Emergency Service.

Event Notification

Resident Notifications will be hand delivered to residents who will be directly affected by the road closures at least two weeks prior to the event.

Access into Carss Bush Park

No weddings are planned on the day of Australia Day. The spaces usually used for wedding photos will all be occupied on the day of Australia Day.

Parking permits will consist of the following;

- Marked Emergency Services Vehicles – Carwar Ave - The spaces around the turning circle near the Lifesaving Hall.
- Stallholder Parking – Bunyala St Car park
- VIP Parking – Dick Caine Car Park and Top area of Carss Park Flats
- Historical Society Volunteers - grassed area near Museum
