RE: DA 2019/20, Front garden, 51 Laycock Rd, Penshurst,


Further to our conversation I am writing to confirm that during conversation I mused to the Building Certifier, Lindsay Dodds, that we might consider removing the proposed, inner (middle) set of garden bed edges (footings) as shown on the plans as it might make the rose garden too narrow.

Once we have received the DA/BC we will commence the plantings of the hedges, trees & gardens and commence work on the outer footings & fountain. We will then make this decision as work progresses and if indeed we do decide to delete the planned garden edge, we will lodge a request to modify the plan which will be simple as the footing trench isn't yet dug.

As you can understand we prefer to do it after the DA etc is finalised as we are desperate to get the planting done during autumn.
